

## Deacon's Diary

*An Invitation to the Heart*

Dear Parishioners

This is my first Deacon's Diary contribution to the monthly Parish Newsletter. It's not a homily, rather it's a brief reflection on some current aspect of our faith journey together. It's no surprise then that this month my Deacon's Diary is about the Holy Season of Lent.

In Lent we are invited to listen and attend with the ear of your heart (St Benedict) to the conversations in the Lenten scriptures – Jesus with the blind man; with the Samaritan woman; with Martha; with the Father. We listen to these words as if they are also addressed to us: 'Do not be afraid', 'I am the light of the world', 'Unbind him and let him go'. In the ebb and flow of each conversation we respond with our concerns, our doubts and our faith.

Our world though is so busy and full of 'noise' often we find it difficult to stop and reflect on what is happening to us; on questions that arise from deep within our hearts. Lent provides an opportunity to 'turn to' this inner dialogue; what are we seeking, what is our heart's desire, what is God's dream for us?

This Lent we are invited to turn again to where God dwells within us – to converse with the word – so that our eyes will be opened, our hearts will be purified, and our minds will be one with Christ Jesus (Philippians 2:6)
