Here's what has happened in the last month and what's to come!

It's been another busy and uplifting month around our parish!

In October maintenance has been a high priority. The church received some muchneeded electrical repairs, and the Finance Committee has been hard at work progressing plans to appoint a builder to complete the repairs to the church façade.

On Wednesday the 22nd of October, 18 of our parish children received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time in a beautiful ceremony. Our heartfelt thanks go to our dedicated catechists, Silvia Kinder and Jenni Hutton, for their guidance and preparation of the children throughout this special journey.

This month, starting on the 14th of November, we are blessed to begin a new Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration each Friday. All are warmly invited to join in this time of silent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. The first three sessions will be dedicated to praying for the complete healing of Fr Richard Rutkauskas.

We are undertaking a review of our safeguarding practices. If you are asked to complete training or provide documentation, we kindly ask that you do so promptly—your cooperation helps ensure our parish remains a safe and caring environment for all.

As cash becomes less common—particularly among the younger generation—we are exploring the introduction of "tap & go" donation options to make giving more convenient. Of course, all our usual collection methods will remain available for those who prefer to give in cash. We're also reaching out to nearby parishes who have already implemented these systems to learn from their experiences.

The planned giving envelopes have arrived (a little later than expected), and are now available for collection at the back of the church.

Finally, our safety and evacuation plans have been updated, we've arranged to have them printed and you'll notice the new signage appearing around the church in the coming weeks.

Safeguarding at St Thomas

It is our collective responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and adults within the Catholic Archdiocese of Perth. As part of our commitment to this, St Thomas is reviewing our safeguarding practices.

Recent updates to the Archdiocese Safeguarding Policy has mandated that volunteers in most ministries including readers, acolytes, flower arrangers, chorists, extraordinary ministers, and even those who participate in the offertory procession are now required to undertake safeguarding training and complete a safeguarding declaration.

The training takes about 45 minutes to complete and can be done online, or in person. In the coming months we will be arranging in-person training at St Thomas, however, there is a training session at St Mary MacKillop Parish on November 15 (see details on the next page) for those who are available.

If you are asked to provide documentation over the coming months please do so promptly as we have a large amount of information to collate.
